

Practice Status/Limitations

Below are examples of common practice status/limitations that may apply to your specific practice situation.

Patient Age Limits

- Practice limited to patients age 0 to 5 years
- Practice limited to patients age 0 to 26 years
- Practice limited to patients age 6 to 12 years
- Practice limited to patients age 13 to 17 years
- Practice limited to patients age 18 to 64 years
- Practice limited to patients age 65 years or older

Patient Population Limits

- Practice limited to native Americans/Indian tribes only
- Practice limited to nursing home patients only
- Practice limited to students only
- Practice limited to homebound geriatric patients
- Unable to accept maternity patients

Services Performed/Provided

- Breast surgery only
- Mohs surgery only
- Retina surgery only
- Home visits only
- Gynecological services only
- Neuropsychology only

Services NOT Performed/Provided

- Surgical procedures not performed
- Mohs surgery not performed
- EKG services not provided
- Radiation therapy not provided
- Marriage counseling not provided
- Hearing aids not provided

Practice Limits

- Floats/covers/fills in for colleagues
- Hospitalist only
- Reads/interprets/performs tests only
- By referral only
- Emergency care limited to existing patients
